

Dr. Yen-Sen Chen is currently a senior research fellow of the National Space Organization, Taiwan. Dr. Chen is a recipient of the NASA/MSFC Software of the Year Award in 2007 and the NASA Software of the Year Award Runner-up in 2008. He has been active in the area of multiphysics CFD model development that includes turbulence, combustion, radiative heat transfer, incompressible to hypersonic flow speeds, fluid-structure interaction (FSI), and parallel computing, particularly in aerospace propulsion system applications. Dr. Chen joined NASA Marshall Space Flight Center soon after receiving his Ph.D. degree in aerospace engineering from the University of Kansas in 1984.
